March 4, 2024**

Lawn Mowing Bids: motion made be Wentworth/Fisher to post accepting sealed until April 30th 2024 bids for mowing Town Hall, Ball Park and School Section Lake Boat Ramp for 2024 Season.

Symco Weekender Rental of Ball Park: Henschel spoke with John Spence about renting ball park for truck and trailer parking for Symco Weekender in August. Looking into option on where Helicopter could land in case of emergency, held over until next month.

Spring Road Tour: Henschel suggested splitting into 2 groups, held over until next month

Land Use Permits: LUPs issued by County for Conex trailers

Fire and Ambulance updates: Old Brush truck sold at auction with funds to be used towards new truck. Raffle tickets still available for April Fund raiser. Pancake Breakfast scheduled for April 28, 2024. Ambulance to raffle of an ATV

Update on Roads: adding 1 load of rocks on Symco Rd by O, Shoulder work needs to be done on West River Rd.

Public Comments/Communications: 1 new cemetery deed, Cemetery Committee to keep safe deposit box in office at town hall, stated on newsletter that GFL will appear as line item on all tax bill, it will only go to residents that use GLF. GFL is still throwing totes in ditch, Henschel will contact them. The Solarus underground line damage to ditch on Symco Rd still not fixed.
