**Beer/Liquor/Cigarette and Operators License:** Motion made by Fisher/Wentworth to approve Licenses as renewed from last year. Ferg's Bavarian Village did not renew their Licenses and Werth Investments applied for a was approved Liquor License from Ferg's.

**Roads:** Grading being done on gravel roads, shoulders and pot holes on Symco road will be worked on, Henschel met with Greg regarding culvert on Postal Rd, Shane Lind called about culvert on White Clover Rd, breaker rock is washing out, needs breaker rock replaced. Fisher and other stated concern for speeding on Symco Rd. It is posted 25 mph as you come into symco, will take with Hwy department on speed sign.

**Public Hearing** will be held on July 8<sup>th</sup> 6:45 pm. regarding Farm Preservation 10 plan.

**Ball Park Rental:** Town has agreed to rent ball park to John Spence for Aug 7<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> for truck and trailer overflow. Agreed to pay Town \$400.00 for rental and to leave park in same condition it was in before event.

**Fire/Ambulance:** 2 more new members, UTV raffle going good. Made repairs to pumper truck, Ambo, 9 pin tourney raised \$2,800, applied for \$10K grant

**Public Comments/Communications:** Had about 110 people for Memorial Day Lunch (hosted by VFW) at town hall. Still getting generator information, UTC asked to close 1 lane on Riske Rd for Spring Pull because grounds were so wet. Rick Thompson offered to help with ditch mowing as he does not work on Fridays.
