Town Board Meeting
October 7th, 2024**

Roads: Zabel and Nollenberg Rd all finished up, Trout Lane wedging & turn around to get done yet, clean ditch and add fill by culvert on White Clover Rd, scheduled to still get done, Cedar Lake Rd and School Section Rd. Mowing is still in process, Henschel is using skid steer to mow deeper

Trash Bills: will be on tax bill as a special change in 2025 for 2024. No longer part of the levy

Newsletter: still working on, will be ready by 11/11/2024 meeting

Public Hearing set for November 11, 2024 at 6:30 for SRF changes

Generator for town hall: discussed installing an emergency generator for the town hall, received 2 quotes, motion made by Fisher/Wentworth to install generator and pay with ARFA funds. Motion carried

Fire/Ambulance: all going good, ambo having a 50/50 raffle

Public Comments: Need to pickup LP tank and place on block at the town hall. Wentworth to represent Union at County Recycle Meeting. Cemetery Committee will meet November 13th at 7pm at the town hall for their annual meeting.
