

Ordinance to Designate Class “B” Roads
Ordinance No: 2018-5

STATE OF WISCONSIN
Town of Union
Waupaca County

The Town Board of the Town of Union, Waupaca County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s. 349.15 (2), Wisconsin statutes, to adopt this ordinance.

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, designates town roads as class “B” roads in the town as follows :

- A. The following town road in the Town of Union is designated class “B’ roads subject to the weight limits set forth in s. 348.16 (2), Wisconsin statutes, unless increased by town ordinance: Riske Road and Luckjohn Road that lies in the Town of Union.
- B. The town chairperson, or his designee, shall place appropriate traffic signs on the above-described roads on or before the effective date of this ordinance.*
- C. No person may operate any vehicle on the above-noted town roads in violation of the weight limits set forth in s.348.16 (2), Wisconsin statutes. Upon conviction for a violation of this ordinance, the violator shall pay a forfeiture of not less than \$100.00 nor more than \$500.00, plus the applicable surcharges, assessments, and costs for each violation. Each trip in violation of this ordinance constitutes a separate offense. In addition, the town board may seek injunctive relief from a court of record to enjoin further violations.

This ordinance is effective on _____, 20____ or on posting after the road sign has been placed.

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s. 60.80, Wisconsin statutes.
