ORDINANCE NO. 2020 - 01

ORDINANCE ADOPTING AN AMENDMENT TO THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN FOR THE TOWN OF UNION

The Town Board of Union, Waupaca County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows: **SECTION 1.** Pursuant to Section(s) 62.23/61.35/60.22(3) of the *Wisconsin Statutes*, the Town of Union is authorized to prepare and adopt a comprehensive plan as defined in Sections 66.1001(1)(a) and 66.1001(2) of the *Wisconsin Statutes*.

SECTION 2. The Town Board, by the enactment of an ordinance, formally adopted the document as the Town comprehensive plan on July 2, 2007.

SECTION 3. The Plan Commission, by a majority vote of the entire Commission at a meeting held on *June 1, 2020*, recommended to the Town Board the adoption of an amendment to change the land use designation of a portion of land located at N8104 Swamp Road, Manawa, Parcel Number 19-19-33-2 (owner Ervin Schmucker) as described or mapped on attached Exhibit A from Forestry to Commercial on the future land use map adopted as part of the comprehensive plan. (The request was done so Mr. Schmucker could operate a metal shop to include custom machine work, with both retail and wholesale of mechanical parts from the property.)

SECTION 4. The Town published or posted a Class 1 public notice and held a public hearing regarding the plan amendment.

SECTION 5. The Town Board of Union, Waupaca County, Wisconsin hereby adopts the proposed plan amendment.

SECTION 6. The Town Clerk is directed to send a copy of this ordinance and the plan amendment to the parties listed in Section 66.1001(4)(b) of the *Wisconsin Statutes*.

SECTION 7. This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage by a majority vote of the full membership of the Town Board and publication or posting as required by law.
