Town Board Meeting
January 5, 2026**

Disbursements: Norton reviewed the December expenses issued check #8398 - 8415 total expenses \$56,704.23. Motion by Artz/Wentworth to approve the expenditures as presented. Motion carried.

New London ATV Club – Visitors from New London ATV Club (Gail) to talk about proper signage. Hwy 22 & 110 is not properly signed or applied for with DOT. They are asking if Town would like to have Club prepare paperwork to amend ordinance to update to be correct. Club will pay for new signage. Also speed limits did raise county wide to speed of the road, Town would have to update ordinance also. Motion made to have New London ATV Club work on paperwork and signage for Town of Union Wentworth/Artz motion carried.

Road Maintenance – Prepaid for snow plowing for December, we received the LRIP for Josse Rd, received 50/50 payment for culvert on E River Road.

Update Garbage/Recycle – Garbage and recycle is now on tax bill for parcels that actually receive service. Town has to cut a check to County for parcels that were charged in error. Payment will be returned to Town at settlement.

Fire/Ambulance: New agreements will be ready for next meeting, added 600 residents in Town of Royalton, all residents in Union are now under MRFD and MRA. Budgets all look good.

Public Comments: MyVote is not updated with current supervisors, Norton will look into. Town Hall meeting in Marion in November, Herman explained process for road grants and audited, only 5% were in compliance, some Towns hire a professional grant writer
