The applicant is proposing to split the parent parcel to create a four acre lot. This property is located within the farmland preservation area. With the farmland preservation area lot splits are controlled by the number of development rights with each development right constituting two acres of land that can be split from the parent parcel. In this particular case the proposed lot split will utilize two development rights to create the four acre parcel. For the lot split to be complete the zoning of the subject area needs to be amended to the Rural Residential Overlay (RR-O) district
