Town Board Meeting
June 1, 2026

Chairman Joel Henschel called the meeting to order at 7:08 p.m. Present were Joel Henschel, Marcy Wentworth, Noah Artz, Kelly Norton and Sandy Werth. Henschel read the open meeting statement. The notice and agenda of the meeting were posted

Agenda: Motion by Artz/Wentworth to approve June 1st, 2026 agenda. Motion carried.

Board Meeting Minutes: Board reviewed the minutes May 4th, 2026 meeting. Motion by Artz/Wentworth to approve minutes, Motion carried

Treasurer's Report: Werth gave report. Checking balance \$120,740.02. Motion by Artz/Wentworth to accept the report as written, Motion carried

Disbursements: Norton reviewed the May 2026 expenses issued check #8462 - 8471 total expenses \$34,121.25. Motion by Wentworth/Artz to approve the expenditures as presented. Motion carried.

Liquor Licenses – Motion made by Artz/Wentworth to approve 5 licenses, Boondocks Bar and Grill, Union Still, Still Phil's Triple O Supper Club, Union Thresherman's Club, motion carries

Roads – Cedar Lake Road is paved, shoulder work still to be done, need to advertise for Jossie Road/LRIP, received bids to reclaim Beaver Road (2 options, 1 – 4" of gravel \$64K 2" of gravel \$39k), Chip seal Symco Rd about \$31K, still picking up brush, mowing to start soon.

UTC asked to make Riske Rd 1 lane June 13th Motion to approve made by Wentworth/Artz, motion carried

Zone Map Changes – Schuelke motion made by Artz/Wentworth to approve zone changes, motion carried

Permits, Land Use – LP & BP Hanson, SLW Phillips, LP Bellin, Larson, Behnke Farms

Fire/Ambulance: Norton Attended all looks good – looking at maybe adding a new 1st Responder division separate from EMS

Public Comments – WTA meeting, asked about reporting road closures during emergency events. Nothing is available now, but understand there is a need. Asked how many unlicensed vehicles are allowed on a property, answer 2. Plaques for service members in Symco cemetery are sinking, (Veterans office is responsible for them), we did have a lot of tree damages. Need no Parking Sign on south side of Symco Road by cemetery. Ball park was surveyed, we set polls marking lot lines, we work with neighbor landowners about leasing land.
